AlertSJSU:

This Community Safety Advisory is being issued by the University Police Department (UPD) and the purpose is to provide information about an incident that occurred on or near campus that does not pose an immediate threat but still pertains to the safety and security of the university community.

**Campus Operations Status:** Normal

**Incident Location:** MacQuarrie Hall

**Date and Time the Incident Occurred (Approximate):** Tuesday, March 24, 2026 at 2:30pm

**General Summary:** University Police were made aware of hateful and threatening graffiti written on a bathroom stall in MacQuarrie Hall. This is similar to antisemitic graffiti found earlier this month and included threats directed at the Jewish community. No evidence of a credible threat has been identified. UPD is continuing to investigate this incident and partner with other law enforcement agencies.

Officer foot patrols will be increased and daily updates will be provided for the rest of the week. We take very seriously our responsibility to help ensure that all SJSU students, faculty and staff, including our Jewish students and colleagues, can safely live, work and study on campus.
