Case Creation Date:

- February 20, 2026

Incident Summary:

- *It was reported that at the Pi Kappa Phi and Alpha Phi social event on February 19-20, 2026, there may have been an incident involving alcohol.*

Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:

- (2) Alcohol
 - A copy of the University's Alcohol Policy shall be provided to each student organization president and must be followed. The University's Alcohol Policy is in compliance with California Law, which prohibits the sale or giving of any alcoholic beverage to any person under the age of 21. Student organizations are in violation of University policy if any individuals under the age of 21 are in possession of alcoholic beverages at an activity sponsored/hosted by the student organization and/or if intoxicated individuals consume alcohol. All student organization presidents must sign an agreement to abide by and uphold the University's Alcohol Policy as well as present an alcohol awareness program to their organizations (should be pre-approved by the Prevention Education Program Center) or arrange for an alcohol awareness program approved by the Prevention Education Program Center. Student organizations sponsoring events are responsible for following the appropriate procedures to prevent underage drinking, including providing alternatives to alcohol.
- (08) Failure to Comply
 - (C) Failure to follow all policies and procedures established by the University pertaining to student organizations, including fraternities and sororities, as outlined in the Student Organizations Handbook.
- (18) Risk Management of Events

Sanctions:

- **Formal Warning effective April 21, 2026.** No disciplinary action will be taken by Student Conduct and Ethical Development on these charges. As a result of Conference, the student organization was informed of San José State University's policies and procedures; henceforth the student organization is placed on notice and is expected to maintain the community standards of the University.
- **Host an Student Wellness Center Workshop for Alpha Phi before May 20, 2026.** Work with Student Wellness Center's Wellness & Health Promotion Team to on this presentation. (Specifically Maleah Herbaugh, Health Promotion Specialist). Attendance of at least 80% of your membership is required, including any new members. (The roster on file with Student Involvement will be used to determine if the attendance requirement was met.) The president is responsible for demonstrating completion by emailing studentconduct@sjsu.edu with a sign-in roster, a photo of the presentation including all members present, or other proof of completion.
