Dear Dr. Qayoumi:

I am writing to report that the Council on Accreditation of Parks, Recreation, Tourism, and Related Professions (COAPRT), at its meeting on October 13, 2014 in Charlotte, NC approved continuing accreditation of the San Jose State University - Department of Health Science and Recreation, Recreation Program and Recreation Therapy Program, until 2021 with the requirement of additional information and/or minor revisions.

The Council approved the following commendations:

- San Jose State University's commitment to accreditation as evidenced by almost 30 years of continuous accreditation.
- High levels of student satisfaction with experiential educational opportunities in courses. (Standard 5.01)
- Practitioner involvement with students in the community and their contributions to exceptional learning opportunities, networking and employment opportunities. (Standard 5.06)

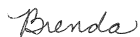
Additionally, the Council requires the following information and/or minor revisions to be sent electronically to COAPRT@nrpa.org:

- The program shall provide evidence that a minimum of two full-time faculty members and a minimum of one additional full time equivalent faculty position (FTE), are assigned to and instruct in the Program. Evidence of compliance shall be provided to Council no later than February 1, 2015. (Standard 1.03)
- The program shall provide evidence that a minimum of two full time faculty members hold a degree of masters or higher and a degree of bachelor's or above in parks, recreation, tourism, and related professions from a regionally accredited institution. Evidence of compliance shall be provided to Council no later than February 1, 2015. (Standard 1.04)
- The program shall provide evidence that full-time faculty members with appointments to the parks, recreation, tourism, and related professions program instruct at least 60 percent of the required courses within the curriculum. Evidence of compliance shall be provided to Council no later than February 1, 2015. (Standard 4.06)

Your institution's accreditation by the COAPRT is valid until the program's next review in the fall of 2021. The program should expect an on-site visit anytime between August - December 2020. To maintain accreditation, the institution must also comply with the Council's requirements for timely submission of annual reports and fees.

The Council is pleased to maintain San Jose State University - Department of Health Science and Recreation - Recreation Program and Recreation Therapy Program on the list of accredited institutions. Congratulations!
